EDUC7572: Innovative Instruction 2.0

This course takes educators into the next level of innovative instruction. Utilizing the H.A.C.K Model of Innovative Instruction, educators will deepen their knowledge of not only how to shift instruction, but also the culture of the classroom where students analyze, evaluate, and create information. Educators will walk away well versed in student-centered instructional practices such as Project-Based Learning (PBL), Blended Instruction, Design Thinking, and Competency-Based Education (CBE) that are common instructional approaches in C (Consistent Application) and K (Knowledge Centered) stages of the H.A.C.K.
